MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Through the joint effort of many local radio-controlled model airplane fliers, 30 acres of open land has been leased Since 1982 from the County of Sacramento for our exclusive use of Model Aircraft, with the right to fly over the Remaining 330 acres. The 40 by 400 foot runway and the covered 30 by 260 foot pit area are completed with a Beautiful asphalt surface.. The address is 11000 Florin Road, one mile east of Excelsior Road, and two miles west of Sunrise Blvd.

There are four types of paid membership available.

OPEN MEMBER: Any member, age 18 or over not listed under one of the below categories. Only open Members have voting privileges. **Membership in the AMA is required.**

COST: \$100.00 New Member Fee, First year annual dues are \$75.00, after first years dues are \$70.00. Dues for **First Time Members** :: will be prorated at a rate of \$6.00 per month.. Dues period is January 1st through December 31 st.

FAMILY MEMBER/JUNIOR MEMBER: Spouse of an OPEN MEMBER and/or children under the age of 18. COSTS: Spouse, \$10.00 annual dues, and No New Member Fee . FAMILY MEMBERS OR JUNIOR MEMBERS under 18 years of age, Initiation fee is deferred until member reaches 18 years of age. Annual dues are \$10.00 until member reaches 18 years of age, then the initiation fee is the same as OPEN MEMBER. Dues **Will not** be prorated.. No Voting Privileges.

BUSINESS MEMBER: A Member who's Business may pose a conflict of interest with SAM activities. Business members have no voting privileges and may not hold elected Office. Dues and Fees same as Open member.

Fees are non-refundable. To qualify for Membership, you must have a current **Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) card In your possession.** Membership in AMA provides both you and the site with liability insurance, which is a requirement of The County of Sacramento and the by-laws of the Sacramento Area Modelers..A " Dispute Resolution Agreement Form" must Be submitted with your Membership application.

S.A.M. meetings are held with place, time and posted. A newsletter is mailed or E mailed monthly to all current members. Flight Instruction and training are available for fliers from beginners to expert.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION AGREEMENT FORM

- A. MEDIATION: All SACRAMENTO AREA MODELERS member, event participants, guests and/or visitors to the SACRAMENTO AREA MODELERS facilities or activities agree to mediate any/all disputes or claims arising between them and the SACRAMENTO AREA MODELERS Bylaws, events or field rules or any other related activity involving SACRAMENTO AREA MODELERS, its members, event participants, guests and/or visitors, before resorting to arbitration or court action. Mediation fees, in any, shall be divided equally among the parties involved. If, for any dispute or claim to which this paragraph applies, any party commences an action without first attempting to resolve the matter through mediation or refuses to mediate after a request has been made, then that party shall not be entitled to recover attorney fees, even if they would otherwise be available to that party in any such action. THIS MEDIATION PROVISION APPLIES WHETHER OR NOT THE ARBITRATION PROVISION IS SIGNED.
- B. ARBITRATION OF DISPUTES: (1) All SAM Club members, event participants, guests and/or visitors to the SAM Club facilities or activities agree that any dispute or claim in Law or equity arising between them which is not settled through mediation, shall be decided by neutral, binding arbitration, including and subject to paragraph (2) below. The arbitrator shall be a retired judge or justice, or an attorney with at least 5 years experience of CALIFORNIA CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE experience, unless the parties mutually agree to a different arbitrator, who shall render an award in accordance with substantive California Law. The Parties shall have the right to discovery in accordance with California Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1283.05. In all other aspects, the arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with Title 9 of a Part III of the California Code of Civil Procedure. Judgment upon the award of the arbitrator(s) may be entered into any court having jurisdiction. The Federal Arbitration Act shall govern interpretation of this agreement to arbitrate.

(2) EXCLUSIONS FROM MEDIATION AND ARBITRATION: Any matter that is within the jurisdiction of small claims court shall be excluded from mediation and arbitration. The filing of a court action to enable the recording of a notice of pending action, for order of attachment, receivership, injunction, or other provisional remedies, shall not constitute a Waiver of the mediation and arbitration provision.

"NOTICE: BY SIGNING IN THE SPACE BELOW YOU ARE AGREEING TO HAVE ANY DISPUTE ARISING OUT OF MATTERS INCLUDED IN THE 'ARBITRATION OF DISPUTES' PROVISIONS DECIDED BY NEUTRAL ARBITRATION AS PROVIDED BY CALIFORNIA LAW AND YOU ARE GIVING UP ANY RIGHTS YOU MIGHT POSSESS TO HAVE THE DISPUTE LITIGATED IN A COURT OR JURY TRIAL. BY SIGNING IN THE SPACE BELOW YOU ARE GIVING UP YOUR JUDICIAL RIGHTS TO DISCOVERY AND APPREA, UNLESS THOSE RIGHTS ARE SPECIFICALLY INCLUDED IN THE 'ARBITRATION OF DISPUTES' PROVISION. IF YOU REFUSE TO SUBMIT TO ARBITRATION AFTER AGREEING TO THIS PROVISION, YOU MAY BE COMPELLED TO ARBITRATE UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE CALIFORNIA CODE OF CIVE PROCEDURE. YOUR AGREEMENT TO THIS ARBITRATION PROVISION IS VOLUNTARY."

"We HAVE READ AND UNDERSTOOD THE FOREGOING AND AGREE TO SUBMIT DISPUTES ARISING OUT OF THE MATTERS INCLUDED IN THE 'ARBITRATION OF DISPUTES' PROVISION TO NEUTRAL ARBITRATION."
