Officer Reports:

President:

1. JR Schiager volunteered to take over as the web master after John Riley died. JR has worked diligently to transform the SAM web page to a modern computer language more easily manipulated and supported. Take a look at it – it's looking great!
2. The FAA has delayed the next rule-making meeting concerning rulings on the Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (SUAS) until February. Being an election year, it is uncertain when proposed rules will be available for public comment.
3. The SAM Open House is scheduled for April 21, 2012. In previous years, the Open House was scheduled at the end of the flying season just prior to youngsters heading back to school. By scheduling it earlier, it allows us to support the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) emphasis on youngster participation by introducing them to modeling at the beginning of the flying season and their summer vacation and then following up with them
4. SAM Projects – major projects have been tabled until our financial position is further evaluated due to a slow membership renewal rate. Past years renewal pattern will be evaluated to determine if this year is an anomaly or if it is a yearly occurrence. Our membership dues are our main source of income. However, if work needs to be completed to save an asset (for example, chip seal the entrance road if it starts to deteriorate beyond repair), it will be completed as we do have sufficient funds.
5. A Special Events application has been submitted to the County for the JR's Charity Event.
6. General membership meeting will be the 4th Tuesday of the month (except February, which is the 3rd Tuesday)

Vice President:

1. Web page set up and still under construction. It includes a signup for a SAM forum and classified ads. If you see ways to improve it or something requiring correction, please contact JR (jrstuff88@gmail.com)
2. A letter will go out in a month for the JR's Charity Event, Keat Raphael Memorial Charity Race..

Secretary:

Nothing at this time.

Treasurer:

1. Reported the club is solvent.
2. Lawn service has been paid for the entire year.
3. \$1,000 lease payment to the County will be paid shortly.

Publicity:

1. Nothing at this time

Membership (provided by President John Bigwood):

1. Large percentage of members have not yet renewed
 - a. 179 members at end of 2011
 - b. 115 members as of January 2012
2. Membership is our primary source of income
3. If you know someone has not renewed, remind them to do so quickly
4. If membership is low, i.e., funding low, the Board will adjust the budget as necessary.

Field Marshall:

1. A creosote burning log was purchased and burned in the fireplace to remove creosote from the chimney. This was a safety issue.
2. Weed spraying is scheduled to be completed.
3. Rodger Cady is in the process of repairing benches (under the cover) that are sagging.

Events Director:

1. The 2012 calendar of events has been approved by the board.

General Business:

1. In light of the lag in new members and the economy, the question of why SAM is continuing with the \$100 initiation fee was raised. It was suggested by "Andy" Anderson it would be better to lower the initiation fee and attract additional members than to keep the fees intact and not attract potential members. President Bigwood said he would take in under advisement with the Board.

2. Another suggestion was to offer Lifetime Memberships again. A discussion followed pointing out the differences of how AMA and SAM are classified for tax purposes and how it affects the member's contributions.
 - a. AMA is a "non-profit" and their lifetime memberships are considered taxable deductible donations that can be claimed on the member's tax return.
 - b. SAM is a "not-for-profit" and their lifetime memberships are not considered tax deductible donations and cannot be claimed on the member's taxes.
 - c. President Bigwood said he would take lifetime membership options under advisement with the Board.
3. A presentation was made by the Ash Creek RC Flyers (ACRCF) from Redding, CA.
 - a. SAM agreed to support and conduct the first Ash Creek RC Flyers' AMA sanctioned War Bird Race scheduled for June 24, 2012. The event is included in SAM's Schedule of Events.
 - i. SAM will run the event with an ACRCF member paired with each SAM member.
 - ii. The race will be Sunday, the 24th. The field will be open Friday and Saturday before the event with practice on Saturday. ACRCF encourages SAM members to come early and bring other planes to fly in addition to their war birds.
 - iii. ACRCF adopted SAM War Bird rules and procedures verbatim.
 - iv. There will be an on-site hobby shop.
 - v. Prizes include YS engines, Justin Boots, A Main Hobby gift certificates and Airborne models.
 - vi. A Huey helicopter will be on display.
 - b. There will be a BBQ Saturday evening, the 23rd.
 - c. Dry camping (no power or water at the campsite) is available at the ACFCF grounds at no cost. Toilets are on site.
 - d. ACRCF's runway is 600 x 60 feet with a view of Mt. Shasta to the north, Mt. Lassen to the east, and is located approximately 15 minutes off Hwy 5.
